ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Whereas, pursuant to 730 ILCS 5/5-6-3.1, the Court shall impose upon a defendant placed on supervision, as a condition of supervision, a fee of \$25 for each month of supervision ordered by the Court, unless after determining the inability of the person placed on supervision to pay the fee, the Court assesses a lesser fee. The fee shall only be imposed upon a defendant who is actively supervised by the Probation Department/Compliance Unit.

Whereas, the Probation Department/Compliance Unit shall, when ordered by the Court, actively supervise those defendants placed on court supervision.

Whereas, the length of time that the Probation Department/Compliance Unit generally supervises those defendants placed on supervision is two months.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, pursuant to 730 ILCS 5/5-6-3.1, that when ordered by the Court, all offenders where a disposition of court supervision is entered in the Circuit Court of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit, Lake County, Illinois, shall actively be monitored by the Probation Officers/Compliance Officers with the Administrative Office of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit, Lake County, Illinois as follows:

- a. Probation Officers/Compliance Officers shall obtain the offender's demographic information.
- b. Probation Officers/Compliance Officers shall monitor the offender's compliance or non-compliance with the conditions of the court supervision.
- c. Probation Officers/Compliance Officers shall advise the Court when an offender is determined to be non-compliant with the terms of court supervision, and shall prepare a written report and file it with the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Lake County in the court file and a copy shall be delivered to the State's Attorney's Office.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that offenders where a disposition of supervision has been entered shall be assessed a fee for each month of supervision ordered by the Court. The fee shall be set at a flat fee of \$50 for two months of supervision unless after determining the inability of the person placed on supervision to pay the fee, the Court assesses a lower fee. The fee shall be paid to the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Lake County, together with any other fees ordered to be paid to that Office, and shall be deposited in the Probation Service Fee Fund.

This Administrative Order becomes effective February 1, 2005.
