The pandemic caused by the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) led the 22nd Judicial Circuit to operate under its Pandemic Continuity of Operations Plan pursuant to the Orders of the Illinois Supreme Court and the Administrative Orders of 22nd Circuit Chief Judge for a period of time during 2020 and 2021.

The 22nd Juridical Circuit is no longer operating under its Pandemic Continuity of Operations Plan and several Administrative Orders, including those concerning masking and social distancing for fully vaccinated individuals, have been vacated by the Chief Judge through Administrative Order 2021-08 entered July 8, 2021 and effective July 12, 2021.

In recognition of the above course of events and after consultation with the Chief Judge and the 22nd Judicial Circuit's provider for Traffic Safety School (TSS) programs, it is NOW ORDERED:

1. Courtroom 102 Standing Order 2020-01 In Re the Matter of Procedures in the Traffic Court Pursuant to The Continuity of Operations Covid-19 Protocols-*Traffic Safety Program* is vacated.
2. Defendants sentenced in Courtroom 102 to complete a 4 hour TSS as a condition of their supervision, unless otherwise ordered, will have the option to complete that class in-person or on-line. The fee, currently set at fifteen dollars (\$15.00), for on-line class participation shall apply.
3. Defendants sentenced in Courtroom 102 to complete an 8 hour TSS as a condition of their supervision, unless otherwise ordered, shall complete that course as directed by the 22nd Judicial Circuit's Traffic Safety Program provider, i.e., in-person, with social distancing and/or masking and/or other conditions as proscribed by the TSS provider.

This Order is effective August 2, 2021.
