In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Illinois Governor J.B. Pritzker, issued Executive Order 2020-32 (COVID-19 Executive Order no. 30) dated April 30, 2020. At Section 1, paragraph 1, that order states:

Any individual who is over age two and able to medically tolerate a face covering (a mask or cloth face covering) shall be required to cover their nose and mouth when in a public place and unable to maintain a six-foot social distance. *Face-coverings are required in public indoor spaces, such as stores.* (emphasis added)

Illinois Governor J.B. Pritzker has also issued a regional five phase plan for the reopening of Illinois ("reopening plan"). McHenry County is in the Northeast Region and sub-region 9. Currently in Phase 2, Illinoisans must at all times and as much as reasonably possible maintain social distancing of at least six feet from any other person and wear face coverings when in public areas. Phases 3 and 4 require that "face coverings and social distancing are the norm."

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. All persons entering and/or remaining in Courtroom 104 shall maintain social distancing of at least six feet from any other person at all times and as much as reasonably possible until such time that McHenry County is in Phase 5 of the reopening plan.
2. All persons entering and/or remaining in Courtroom 104 shall cover their nose and mouth with a face-covering until such time that McHenry County is in Phase 5 of the reopening plan.
