McHENRY COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2007-10 22nd JUDICIAL CIRCUIT McHENRY COUNTY, ILLINOIS

GRAND JURY

Upon the petition of the State's Attorney of McHenry County and the Court being fully advised in the premises, the Court FINDS:

Pursuant to the Rules of Practice of the Circuit Court of the 22nd Judicial Circuit, McHenry County, Illinois, and the applicable statutes of the State of Illinois, as is necessary that a Grand Jury be convened at least once a week in McHenry County, Illinois;

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED, as follows:

- 1. That the Grand Jury shall be impaneled twelve (12) times per year.
- 2. That each Grand Jury shall be convened on the first Thursday of each month, however, should the first Thursday of the month be a Court holiday, then the Grand Jury shall convene on the second Thursday of the month in that year. The Grand Jury shall convene on each Thursday of the month and on the second, third and fourth Wednesday of the month from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. each session.
- 3. That no Grand Jury shall convene for sessions on more than two days each week without the authorization of the Presiding Judge of the Criminal Division or the Chief Judge.
- 4. That each Grand Jury chosen, impaneled or sworn for each term of service shall serve until the next Grand Jury is so chosen, impaneled and sworn.
- 5. That no Grand Jury shall convene on a day that Court is not in session without authorization of the Presiding Judge of the Criminal Division or the Chief Judge.
- 6. This Administrative Order is effective as of April 2, 2007 and McHenry County Administrative Order No. 95-3 is vacated.
