

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2010-06

McHENRY COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

**ORDER RESTRUCTURING THE McHENRY COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF
PROBATION AND COURT SERVICES UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE
TRIAL COURT ADMINISTRATOR**

WHEREAS, 730 ILCS 110/15 (2)(a) states: “The Chief Judge of each circuit shall provide full-time probation service for all counties within the circuit, in a manner consistent with the annual probation plan, the standards, policies and regulations established by the Supreme Court”; and

WHEREAS, the National Center for State Courts, Mr. Gordon Griller and Mr. Kevin Bowling completed the Governance and Leadership Structure Review and Recommendations for the Twenty-Second Judicial Circuit in July of 2008; and

WHEREAS, it was recommended that “A closer, formal organizational relationship between Court Administration and the Court Services Department beginning in an advisory capacity and ending in a restructuring under the Trial Court Administrator when a new Chief Probation Officer is appointed after the current Chief retires”; and

WHEREAS, the current Director of the McHenry County Department of Probation and Court Services has announced his retirement effective December 31, 2010.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that effective January 1, 2011, the McHenry County Department of Probation and Court Services shall be restructured under the office of the Trial Court Administrator;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the attached organizational chart is hereby adopted effective January 1, 2011, as the organizational structure of the Twenty-Second Judicial Circuit of McHenry County, Illinois.
