

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2015-03
22ND JUDICIAL CIRCUIT
MCHENRY COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

**ORDER REGARDING THE DRAWING OF PETIT AND GRAND JURORS FOR THE
CIRCUIT COURT OF THE 22ND JUDICIAL CIRCUIT, MCHENRY COUNTY, IL**

IT IS HERBY ORDERED that any prior Administrative Orders pertaining to the drawing of petit and grand jurors are hereby vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the McHenry County Jury Commission is directed to act under the authority of the Chief Judge and draw sufficient names of residents of McHenry County to serve as petit and grand jurors.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that such names will be randomly drawn by computer as authorized by 705 ILCS 310/8(c).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a petit juror's term of service will be for one day, or for one trial, if impanelled. A Grand juror's term of service shall be for one month.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that sufficient names shall be drawn so one hundred (100) qualified petit jurors are present on Mondays; seventy-five (75) qualified petit jurors are present on Tuesdays; and an amount deemed appropriate by the Jury Commission for Wednesdays, as needed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the McHenry County Jury Commission has the discretionary authority to vary the amount of qualified jurors summoned when such circumstances warrant.
