**ORDER SUSPENDING EXECUTION OF EVICTION ORDERS
DURING INCLEMENT WEATHER AND CERTAIN DATES OF THE YEAR**

IT IS HERBY ORDERED that the Sheriff of McHenry County shall cease the execution of Eviction Orders relating to residential real estate:

1. Whenever the outside air temperature is 25 degrees Fahrenheit or colder on the actual date of the eviction; or
2. Whenever the outside heat index is above 110 degrees Fahrenheit on the actual date of the eviction; or
3. Whenever, regardless of temperature, extreme weather conditions exist or are predicted to exist by the National Weather Service, including, but not limited to:
 - a. Severe Thunderstorm Watch
 - b. Severe Thunderstorm Warning
 - c. Tornado Watch
 - d. Tornado Warning
 - e. Winter Weather Advisory
 - f. Winter Storm Watch
 - g. Winter Storm Warning
 - h. Blizzard Watch
 - i. Blizzard Warning
 - j. High Heat Warning

on the actual date of eviction, which could endanger the health and well-being of those to be evicted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Sheriff of McHenry County shall cease the execution of Eviction Orders between the dates of December 21st and January 2nd on any calendar year.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any judge in the 22nd Judicial Circuit may, in the exercise of his or her judicial discretion in any pending case and for good cause shown, enter a specific Order which clearly states that this Administrative Order is being superseded and the reason(s) therefore; and which clearly orders and directs the Sheriff of McHenry County to execute the Eviction Order without delay.
