WHEREAS, the Office of Statewide Pretrial Services (OSPS) serves as the pretrial services agency for Illinois counties upon request by the county. Pretrial Services Agencies are mandated by statute to provide accurate background data regarding the pretrial release of persons charged with certain offenses and to supervise compliance with the terms and conditions ordered upon release. *725 ILCS 185/1, et.seq*; and

WHEREAS, the 22nd Circuit Court Services and Probation Department (hereinafter "Probation") has heretofore been providing pretrial services, including pretrial supervision, to defendants in McHenry County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, OSPS and the 22nd Judicial Circuit have reached an agreement for OSPS to serve as the pretrial services agency for the 22nd Judicial Circuit, commencing March 2, 2026.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that OSPS shall assume all pretrial services responsibilities involving the supervision of defendants ordered to pretrial supervision on and after March 2, 2026.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that on March 16, 2026, OSPS shall assume pretrial services and responsibilities including the supervision of all defendants ordered to pretrial supervision prior to, on, and after March 2, 2026.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Probation and OSPS may share information regarding defendants under their respective jurisdictions.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that as of March 2, 2026, OSPS personnel shall have elevated access to IJustice records (including impounded criminal and juvenile cases), and SOMA data needed to prepare reports and to monitor defendants on pretrial supervision.
